



"RAISE THE ROOF" FINAL UPDATE:


Thank you for Raising the Roof! This is a parish success story. Bill Wulf, our Facilities Manager, determined that three sections of our school roof received failing grades and needed to be replaced. He secured five quotes. After discussion by the Buildings and Grounds Committee and Finance Council, he secured an additional three quotes, and a decision was made to proceed with the lowest cost, highest quality bid. Work began in July and was completed in August. The total cost of the project was \$289,220.00. Funding came from the following sources:

- · Maintenance green envelopes: \$35,573.53
 - · Match: \$86,000.00
- · Raise the Roof Raffle: \$32,725.00
- GRACE facilities grant: \$10,000.00
- · SAC facilities gift: \$10,000.00
- · Total raised: \$174,289.53
- Balance taken from Campus Maintenance Fund: \$114,930.47






