

Changing to meet your needs!

St. John the Baptist is adding a new area behind the current chapel in the Holy Sepulchre Cemetery to provide a convenient, dedicated place for people who select cremation for interment. This area will consist of an urn garden and columbarium.

Urn Garden

Urn garden plots are areas dedicated for the burial of a sealed urn in a 2 foot square plot. Each plot will hold up to two sets of cremains. This is a great option if you are more comfortable with the burial option, similar to a traditional full body casket burial.

Columbarium

A columbarium is an above ground, outside, stone structure. It has numerous small vaults referred to as "niches". Each niche will hold up to two sets of cremains. This is a great option if you prefer above ground burial and/or wish to have two sets of cremains interned together.

With choosing cremation...

- 1. We include the marker for either an urn garden plot or columbarium niche.
- 2. You need to purchase an urn instead of a casket and vault.
- 3. You need to purchase the engraving.
- 4. You pay a lower burial fee.

Can Catholics be cremated?

The Catholic Church has accepted cremation for over fifty years and expresses that, as with a body of the deceased, "the ashes of the faithful must be laid to rest in a sacred place, that is, in a cemetery or, in certain cases, in a church or an area, which had been set aside for this purpose" (Instruction Ad resurgendum cum Christo, 5).

Why choose an urn garden plot or columbarium niche?

Spiritual site for final resting:
 There is comfort in knowing your loved ones are at rest on sacred grounds, near their place of worship.

• Serene environment:

A columbarium provides a peaceful and meaningful environment for visitors to meditate, silently reflect, and memorialize their loved ones.

• Perpetual care:

A portion of your fee goes towards guaranteeing maintenance of the grounds.

• Simplicity of planning:

Purchasing a niche or urn garden plot minimizes the number of decisions you need to make at the time of need.
