




Interested in Shaping the Future of St. John's?

NOVENA IN PREPARATION FOR PENTECOST: MAY 28

Nine days passed between Ascension Thursday and Pentecost. The followers of Jesus chose these days of prayer to prepare for the coming of the Holy Spirit.
